*Why consider it?*

- direct and shortest pathway to polytechnic education
- provide strong academic foundation for diploma courses with a **focus on applied learning**
- earlier exposure to polytechnic type of learning – project work, industry-relevant skills
- admission through broad clusters – greater **flexibility** in pathways and more time for **exploration**







Placement in course will be confirmed if **N-level results meet** the Minimum Entry Requirements (**MERs**) of the course.







**ITE Early Admissions Exercise (ITE EAE)**



### DPP

- Students who do not decide by the stipulated deadline will be deemed to have **accepted their DPP offer**.

### PFP

- Students with confirmed ITE EAE offers may progress to ITE first and apply for PFP in January.
- Students who accepted a PFP offer may then withdraw from the ITE EAE course.

2. Roleplay interview for EAE application. ————— Practice common interview questions with your child to boost his/her confidence.
3. Encourage your child to speak to his/her seniors who have gone through the EAE admission exercise. ————— This will give your child a better idea of what to expect at different phases of the EAE application.
